**Preparing for Publication in *The Review of Higher Education*:  
Instructions to Authors**

*Congratulations* on having your manuscript accepted for publication in *The Review of Higher Education*! There are several instructions that we need for you to follow and materials returned to our office at the University of Houston.

1. Please read and sign the Publishing Agreement with Johns Hopkins University Press.
2. Save a copy of your paper on a DOS-formatted disk or CD for the Copy Editor. Please adhere to the following requirements:
  - Manuscripts should be submitted in APA style for citations, notes, and references.
  - Use *italics*, not underlining in the references.
  - Please indicate the program (e.g. Microsoft Word XP, Word Perfect 6.0) on the label.
  - Limit the title of your article to no more than 4 decks and 28 characters per line.
3. Send biographical information on the author(s) of the manuscript including: academic title or position and the name of each author's institutional affiliation (including the city and state in which the university is located if either or both are not part of the institution's name). The biographical note needs to be written in the third person. Please include the name, address, and e-mail of the person to contact if a reader wishes to respond to your article.
4. If you have not already done so, please provide an abstract of your article. This abstract needs to be no longer than 100 words and written in the third person. It should summarize the research problem, data sources, major findings and, if appropriate, major recommendations.
5. Mail your disk or CD, the Publishing Agreement, and a hard copy of your manuscript to:

6. Please indicate the name, address, fax, and e-mail address of the author who will be the lead contact for the Copy Editor. Remember, if you change your institutional affiliation, please be sure to let us know.


